2019 - 2020 CODE OF CONDUCT

We, The Stampede Yearbook staff commit to the following traditional rules:

We understand that, as members of the Stampede Yearbook Staff, we hold ourselves to a high standard of behavior and performance and are accountable for our actions.

We uphold the values of the SDUHSD academic honesty policy:

- To not cheat on tests. This means any intention of giving of or use of external assistance relating to an examination, test, quiz, or project without express permission of the teacher. This includes looking on another student's paper, sharing answers, or copying another student's paper.
- To not plagiarize. This means any intentional representation of another's ideas, words, or work as one's own. Plagiarism includes the misuse of published material, electronic material, and/or the work of other students.
- To not commit forgery. This means any unauthorized signing of another person's name to school related documents.

We uphold the values of the California Education Code:

- To not possess, sell, or otherwise furnish a firearm.
- To not brandish a knife at another person.
- To not harm another student, teacher, or visitor on campus.
- To not use any illegal drugs or substances, or drugs that are not authorized by the school or prescribed by a physician.
- To not consume any alcoholic beverages.

We uphold the values of the Maverick Ambassador Programs:

- To always represent myself, my program, and my school in a positive and professional manner, both in person and on social media.
- Participate in all required events; missed hours will need to be made up.
- To be accountable and responsible for direct and professional communication with adviser and class leaders.

- To not use our position on staff to elevate ourselves or our friends in photos, spreads, interviews, etc.
